YOUTH SIZZLIN' HOOPS

PROGRAM INFORMATION

1. It is the intent of this program to offer a fun, recreational opportunity for area youth to demonstrate their basketball abilities.
2. The program is tentatively scheduled to begin the end of May.
3. **All teams will be PRE-DETERMINED prior to registration. Teams will NOT be randomly assigned (please note this difference from the winter MPR Youth Basketball League).**

REGISTRATION & FEES

1. **Registration will begin the beginning of April and will continue through mid April.** Registration will be accepted for teams with a **minimum of 8 per team and a maximum of 12.**
2. The team roster, player contracts and player fees is required at the time of registration.
3. **FEES: Early Bird - first week of registration - \$35/Player**
 Regular - after first week - \$50/Player
A parent's signature is required on contracts if the player is under 18 years of age. All forms are available at the Maryville Community Center.
4. Registration will be conducted at the Maryville Community Center, 1407 N. Country Club Rd. Teams may register during facility hours. **TEAMS MUST REGISTER AS AN ENTIRE UNIT (THE COACH OR MANAGER SHOULD BRING IN THEIR TEAM FORM, AND ALL PLAYER FEES AND WAIVERS AT ONCE FOR HIS/HER INDIVIDUAL TEAM).**
5. Registration is on a first come, first serve basis. There will be a maximum of 12 teams per division and there must be a minimum of 4 teams per division to conduct an age group.

SCHEDULES

1. Each team will play a total of six games in the evenings throughout June and July. All games will be played at the Maryville Community Center, beginning tentatively **at the end of May.**
2. Game times will occur at **6:00, 7:00, 8:00, and 9:00 pm.**
3. Schedules will be distributed at the coaches meeting mid May in the Large Meeting Room at the Community Center.
4. In case a team can't play a scheduled game, MPR must know at least two (2) days in advance, otherwise it will be ruled a forfeit.

RULES OF CONDUCT

1. All players, coaches and fans are expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner. We will not tolerate unsportsmanlike conduct, disrespect, or poor attitude at any time.
2. If a player receives a technical foul, they will be removed from that game, and the next scheduled game for his/her team.
3. Any person suspended for any reason will be required to meet with the Recreation Coordinator and Recreation Supervisor before participating or attending any other games.

4. We expect the coaches to set an example for their team and assist us in providing good sportsmanship at all contests. We encourage coaches to have all players participate at each game.
5. The official's call is **FINAL!** Arguing with the officials will NOT be tolerated in this program.

GENERAL RULES

1. The 2017-2018 National Federation High School Basketball Rules will be followed for this program, except for the following exceptions.
2. Fouls will be recorded by the scorekeepers. As in the NFHS Basketball Rules, teams will enter into Bonus at the 7th team foul. A Double Bonus will be reached at the 10th team foul. An individual who has committed five (5) personal fouls will leave the game.
3. Games will consist of two twenty (20) minute halves, with a five (5) minute half time. The clock will run continuously, except for the last minute of each half when the clock will stop on all dead balls. The clock does not stop for free throws until the last minute of each half.
4. Point Spread: Grades 3-8 will have a 20 point rule. At the half or anytime after when the score difference is 20, play may continue, but the score will not be kept. Grades 9-12 will have a 30 point rule.
5. Full-Court Press: Grades 3-6 may only use a full court press in the last one minute of each half. Grades 7-12 may use a full court press at any time throughout the game.
6. The 3 point rule will be in effect for all age groups.
7. If the score is tied at the end of regulation, a three (3) minute overtime period will be held. If the score remains tied, "sudden death" overtime will be held; the first team to score wins the game.
8. A player or bench personnel receiving a technical foul will result in ejection from the game; in addition, the individual will be suspended from their next game.
9. No dunking will be allowed – this results in a two shot technical foul on the offending player and removal for the rest of the game. However, the player will be allowed to participate in their next scheduled game.
- 10. A team must have 5 players to start the game. Game time is forfeit time!!**
11. Players must check in with the scorer and wait until summoned onto the court by an official.
12. Three forfeits and the team will be dropped from league play.
13. If a player who is not registered on your roster participates, your team will forfeit that particular game. A person who participates without paying the correct fee will not be allowed to participate in any games throughout the year.
14. Teams will be allowed a total of four (4) one-minute time-outs per game.
15. The free-throw line will be at 10 ft. for the 3rd and 4th graders. All other grades will shoot from the regulation free-throw line.

PROTESTS

Only protests involving ineligible players will be allowed. Coaches must file the protest with the officials or the scorekeeper prior to the end of the game. The Recreation Supervisor will determine the legality of the player(s).

CANCELLATIONS

1. Games will only be canceled due to extreme weather conditions or emergencies at the schools. Listen to KNIM (97.1 FM) or call (660) 562-2923 for status of games that evening. **Please do not call KNIM.**

T-SHIRTS

Each player will receive a t-shirt. Every team in each grade will have their own color of shirts with identification numbers on them. MPR will randomly assign numbers to players.

ADMISSION

A \$1.00 admission fee will be charged for all adult spectators. Folding chairs will be available for spectator seating, or spectators may bring **clean** lawn chairs for seating.
